

**Make sure your ballot is counted.**

Federal law requires that you provide identification either before or when you vote. **If you fail to provide identification, your ballot will not be counted.**

You may provide identification now, or include a photocopy with your ballot. In order to protect the secrecy of your vote, do not place the photocopy inside the security envelope.



Why is this upside you ask? Because the USPS does not allow for open bottom edges.

It's possible you won't be able to read the voters hand writing upon the cards return. As a means to identify the voter pre-print their name, mailing address and voter ID than barcode (if used).

! It's important to print the ID number before the barcode for USPS processing.
